

KRISHI KALYAN ABHIYAN PHASE -I

Implemented in 25 villages in each of the 117 Aspirational Districts from 1st June to 31st July, 2018 and Extend up to 15th August 2018

Krishi Kalyan Abhiyan undertakes various activities to promote best farming practices and enhance Agricultural income

The Ministry of Agriculture and farmers' welfare in line with the Hon'ble Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of doubling farmers' income by 2022 has launched the Krishi kalyan Abhiyaan from 1st June, 2018 till 31st July, 2018 so as to aid, assist and advice farmers on how to improve their farming techniques and raise their incomes. The Krishi kalyan Abhiyaan will be undertaken in 25 Villages with more than 1000 population each in Aspirational Districts identified in consultation with Ministry of Rural Development as per directions of NITI Ayog. In districts where number of villages (with more than 1000 population) is less than 25, all villages will be covered.

An Action Plan comprising specifically identified activities under various departments of the ministry namely, Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers Welfare (DAC&FW), Animal Husbandry Dairying & Fisheries (DAHD&F) and Department of Agricultural Research & Education (DARE-ICAR) will be implemented to saturate these 25 villages in each district with these activities.

The overall coordination and implementation in the 25 villages of a district is being done by Krishi Vigyan Kendra of that district. 111 officers have also been made in-charge of one district each for overall coordination and field level monitoring. These officers have been selected from subordinate/attached/autonomous organizations/PSUs etc. of Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare. Various activities to promote best practices and enhance agriculture income are being undertaken under this plan such as:-

- 1) Distribution of Soil Health Cards to all farmers
- 2) 100% coverage of bovine vaccination for Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) in each village
- 3) 100% coverage of Sheep and Goat for eradication of Peste des Petits ruminants (PPR)
- 4) Distribution of Mini Kits of pulses and oilseeds to all
- 5) Distribution of Horticulture/Agro Forestry/Bamboo plant @ 5 per family(location appropriate)
- 6) Making 100 NADAP Pits in each village
- 7) Artificial insemination saturation

- 8) Demonstration programmes on Micro- irrigation
- 9) Demonstrations of integrated cropping practice
